The bid solicitation for resurfacing roads in Union County, Project #19 -07-101 is hereby amended to reflect additional quantities needed in connection with the resurfacing of Lovers Lane Road. Pavement marking quantities for this road erroneously were omitted from the initial Bid Document. Other quantities have been increased by the amount in the bid form for this addendum. Also, the contractor will be required to prepare road for resurfacing, resurface and install permanent pavement markings on Lovers Lane Road.

The bid form that follows must accompany the original bid form of the bid document and the amount bid on the addendum bid form will be added to the total base bid for purposes of awarding the contract for this project.

Also, from pre-bid meeting:

- Temporary centerline paint will be required immediately after re-paving until permanent thermo markings can be installed. The cost of temporary markings will be absorbed into your cost of yellow double centerline thermo markings. No temporary edge lines will be required.
- Driveway turnouts will be 2' in width.
- No shoulder leveling will be required on this contract other than isolated areas as directed by the engineer. This work will be paid for under reshape ditches unit cost in contingency bid items.

- .01 DESCRIPTION:** This work shall consist of furnishing and installing 4” & 8” Yellow or White permanent thermoplastic pavement marking lines. Locations of lines to be placed will be installed in same position as lines remove and/or as directed by the Engineer. Layout will be according to SCDOT Standard Drawings. This work shall include all materials, equipment, labor, and incidentals necessary to complete the work.

- .02 MATERIALS:** Refer to the SCDOT 2007 Standard Specifications for Highway Construction Section 627.2 in its entirety.

- .03 EQUIPMENT:** Refer to the SCDOT 2007 Standard Specifications for Highway Construction Section 627.3 in its entirety.

- .04 CONSTRUCTION:** Refer to the SCDOT 2007 Standard Specifications for Highway Construction Section 627.4 in its entirety. See SCDOT Standard Drawing 625-415-00 for Railroad Crossing Symbol placement.

- .05 MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT:** 4” & 8” Yellow and white permanent thermoplastic solid lines will be measured and paid for at the Contract Unit Price bid per lineal foot. The payment will be full compensation for all material, labor, equipment, tools, and incidentals necessary to complete the work.

ADDITIONAL CLARRIFICATIONS OF BID DOCUMENT

This section further explains how the Union County plans to treat the contract for this bid. It is anticipated that the low bid amount will possibly exceed the amount of funds Union County has currently allocated for this project. Whatever the submitted bid amount, the project will be awarded to the lowest base bid total, including this addendum, to a qualified bidder. However, the initial contract amount will be for approximately one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to pave as many roads on the “2019 Union County Road Paving List” as possible. Lower priority roads on this list will be paved as additional CTC funds become available and the contract will be amended to reflect the amended contract amount with the mutual agreement of both parties.

Parking lots and non-road paving projects have other funding sources and will be handled as separate projects and billed separately. However, the award of the bid to the successful bidder will also justify award of individual non road paving projects to the low bidder for the “2019 Union County Road Paving List”. This will be treated similar to an “on call” contract.

The initial term of the contract awarded under this bid solicitation will expire December 31, 2021; however, it may be terminated without cause by either party anytime after July 31, 2020.
