Union County is accepting applications for the position of Public Works Foreman. As Foreman, the successful candidate will report directly to the Public Works Director and will be responsible for supervising skilled and semi-skilled workers in various duties related to maintenance of the county road system and solid waste recycling division. Will assist in short and long range plans for the crew and coordinate a weekly schedule for needed work. Must be able to complete reports, and collect data. Will operate medium to heavy equipment in a wide range of activities including preventative maintenance and construction. Supervises and instructs personnel in operation of equipment and proper practices for construction and safety, as well as all other duties assigned by the public works director. Must be willing to submit to all pre-employment testing, SCDMV record check, criminal history check, and drug screen. A High School Diploma or GED is required, must hold Class A CDL. A minimum of five years' experience in road/bridge maintenance is desired with some of that time being in a lead laborer or supervisory role; or any other combination of experience and education deemed suitable by the hiring manager.

All Full-Time positions are eligible for Health, Dental, Vision and Life benefits through SC PEBA. Membership in the State of South Carolina Retirement System is required.
